#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL

# **IMPORTANT PARENT REMINDERS**

#### Lee County School Board Policy 4.16:

No student shall be released within the final 30 minutes of the school day unless the principal/designee determines it is an emergency.

#### Being in school is important

It is important that our students are in school everyday and that they are on time for each class, including the beginning of the day. Just as students receive a detention during the day for being tardy to classes, students will also receive a detention on every third unexcused tardy to school. Therefore, every 3rd unexcused tardy will result in an after school detention.

#### School Clinic/COVID-19 Notice

If your child goes to the school clinic during the course of the day and complains of any symptom related to COVID-19, they will be sent home for 10 days unless they return with a doctors note explaining that your child symptoms are not related COVID-19.

#### Picking up your student

Student must be picked up at dismissal each day, 4:00 pm, or at the designated end time of any school sponsored event.
